Parking Permit Purchases Begin July 20th

Stillwater, Okla. – The Department of Parking and Transit Services will be offering online permit purchases beginning **July 20th** for Faculty/Staff and Students. Permits must be purchased online at www.parking.okstate.edu by clicking the “Purchase a Permit” link. If necessary, kiosks are provided at the OSU Parking Office for online purchases.

The following types of permits must be purchased in the OSU Parking Office located in the new Multi-Modal Transportation Facility: new faculty/staff, vendor, handicapped, university vehicle, carpooling, emeriti, construction, registration, or special permits.

As with each changing year, OSU Parking Services has made a few changes of its own.

- First, motorcycle permits will now be purchased online. The date for motorcycle permit purchases is also **July 20th**.
- Second, in order to solve the issue of “Lost in Mail Permits” permit purchasers will have the option to print a temporary permit and use the permit during a seven (7) day period until a new permit can be mailed; however, if the new permit is not received within the seven (7) day period, the Parking Services Office must be contacted immediately. Failure to contact the Parking Office ten (10) days after the temporary permit has expired will result in a \$10.00 permit replacement fee.
- Finally, bicycle registration will be available without charge at the new Multi-Modal Transportation Terminal located at the corner of Monroe and Hall of Fame.

Also, in past years, faculty/staff were given a Quick Reference Parking Guide with the purchase of a parking permit; however, no guides will be mailed this year. To obtain a guide, please pick one up at the new Multi-Modal Transportation Terminal or view the document online at www.parking.okstate.edu. Students will still receive a guide.
